Experienced Prevention Specialists are also responsible for effectively guiding school communities through comprehensive prevention planning efforts.

This position requires superb presentation skills and the ability to work effectively in many settings with a variety of groups. ***This position also requires that the candidate be in long-term, healthy recovery from substance use,*** as our educational programs include sharing our own knowledge and experience to make a positive difference in the lives of young people, their families, and their school communities. Experience working with youth and/or within a school setting is a plus. Because FCD works with schools and communities on five continents around the globe, foreign language fluency (especially Spanish) is also desirable.

Extensive training will be required for the position. A new Prevention Specialist, upon successful completion of the initial training, will work on teams with experienced Prevention Specialists prior to independent work in the field. Candidates should be able to work flexibly on a per-diem basis as needed by FCD's scheduling requirements. Travel, sometimes for a week or more at a time, is likely.
